- A family picture to hang in your cubby
- A 1 inch, 3-ring binder with a clear clover sleeve (Please label with your child's name) (Brown, Hunt, and Taylor only)

Social Studies:

- 1 purple folder with pockets

*Our subjects are color-coded. If you cannot find these colors, it is fine. Just make sure that you have a different color for each subject. Laminated (heavier) folders work best.
