

Thank you for submitting your CRRSA Act Combined Funding Application. I have been assigned to review your application.

Per the June 18, 2021 memo from Phyllis D. Morris, Chief Finance Officer at NYSED, LEAs were advised that ESSER 2 allocations were revised. As such I am reaching out to suggest a change in your ESSER 2 budget to reflect the full revised allocation.

Original ESSER 2 allocation	\$720,459
Revised ESSER 2 allocation	\$720,792
Increase in ESSER 2 allocation	\$333
